

# Shoreline Sign Treatment Notice Template

Please follow the instructions on this cover page when filling in treatment notices.

This is a generic template for shoreline signs and treatment notices under the Washington State Department of Ecology's aquatic pesticide general permits. You may use this generic template and customize it to match the requirements for each treatment product. Check the FIFRA label for each chemical to ensure you are displaying the correct use restrictions. Edit the template and **remove the advisories that do not apply**. For questions on how to use the templates, contact the permit manager listed on the Aquatic Pesticide Permit web page:

- **Pictograms:** Pictograms are required for each use restriction. You can add or remove pictograms to each treatment notice as appropriate.
- **Signal words:** refer to the product label for the correct signal word (e.g. Caution, Warning, Danger, etc.).
- **Chemical Name:** Include the name(s) of the active ingredients.
- **Treatment Date:** Include the date(s) the treatment will take place.
- **Use Restrictions:** Refer to the product label for applicable use restrictions (e.g. fishing, irrigation, livestock etc.). Add any missing use restrictions and hazards. For each use restriction, include the date on which the restriction ends, and indicate a time if 24 hours or less.
- **Contact Information:** Include the name and contact phone number for the treatment applicator and property/project manager, or other people who can answer questions about the treatment.
- **Hazards:** Refer to the product label for hazards (e.g. skin irritation, eye irritation, etc.).
- **Permit Number:** Fill in your permit coverage number.
- **Comments:** Delete all guidance comments in the margin before printing the template.
