DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Proposed Action: Notice of Construction Order No. 16068

Description of proposal:

Weyerhaeuser NR Company (Weyerhaeuser) currently operates a log sorting and export yard located along the Columbia River in Longview, Washington. A portion of the sorted logs are debarked prior to export using either the large or small debarker. Weyerhaeuser proposes to replace the existing large debarker and the single-bay bark bin. The proposed replacement debarker has twice the capacity of the current debarker. The proposed bark bin is also twice the capacity of the current bark bin.
