STATE ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY ACT
DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Proposed Action: NOC Order No. 16293

Description of proposal:

Port Townsend Paper Corporation (PTPC) is proposing to install a continuous pulper for pulping Old Corrugated Containers (OCC). The new pulper will replace the existing batch pulper. The new pulper will be able to produce 720 air dried tons of pulp (ADTP) per day which is an increase from the 480 ADTP per day capacity of the existing batch pulper. There will be associated increases in average production at Paper Machines 1 and 2.
