**Description of proposal:** The proposal is related to the No. 5 Power Boiler at Georgia-Pacific Consumer Operations LLC (formerly known as Fort James Camas LLC). The boiler was previously converted from an existing magnesite recovery furnace and permitted to burn natural gas to produce steam, in accordance with Notice of Construction (NOC) Order No. DE-1147-AQ04 issued on June 30, 2004. The NOC also allowed burning of pulp mill non-condensable gases (NCGs), steam stripper off-gas (SOGs) and fuel oil. The proposal is to modify the NOC, removing NCGs, SOGs, and fuel oil from the list of materials to be burned; the limits and monitoring requirements associated with the burning these fuel/streams will be removed from the NOC and Air Operating Limit WA0000256.
