Description of proposal: Ecology issued Notice of Construction (NOC) Order No. 3462-AQ07 on February 23, 2007 as an administrative change to NOC Order No. DE 01AQIS-3294 that was originally issued on December 14, 2001. WestRock Longview, LLC (WestRock Longview) is requesting to modify NOC Order No. 3462-AQ07 to remove retired emission units and revise opacity requirements. The modification does not allow any additional construction or any increases in emissions.
