STATE ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY ACT DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE ADOPTION of EXISTING DOCUMENT

Description of proposal: Ecology initially issued Notice of Construction (NOC) Order No. DE 99AQIS-94 on January 24, 2000 to Simpson Tacoma Kraft Company to approve modifications to Recovery Furnace No. 4. The modifications included the replacement of an indirect liquor heater and installation of a third level of combustion feed air (tertiary air). It has been proposed that Order No. DE 99AQIS-94 be amended to clarify the requirements associated with the Order. The amendment does not allow any additional construction or any increases in emissions.

Amendments to the NOC Order include:

- 1. The Permittee has been changed from Simpson Tacoma Kraft Company to WestRock CP, LLC.
- 2. A reduction in minimum stack testing frequency of Particulate Matter at Recovery Boiler No.4.
- 3. The incorporation of amendments to Order No. DE 99AQIS-94 which were made by reference via Order No. 1916-AQ05. This includes the removal of a NOx limit and algorithm which were superseded in subsequent NOC Orders and an update to an annual oil capacity calculation.
