**STATE ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY ACT
DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE
ADOPTION of EXISTING DOCUMENT**

Description of proposal: Ecology initially issued Notice of Construction (NOC) Order No. DE 01AQIS-3114 on July 25, 2001 to Simpson Tacoma Kraft Company to approve a modification of Recovery Furnace No.4. The modification included the replacement of two existing laminar air heaters with an economizer. It has been proposed that Order No. DE 01AQIS-3114 be amended to update compliance demonstration requirements. The amendment does not allow any additional construction or any increases in emissions.

Amendments to the NOC Order include:

1. The Permittee has been changed from Simpson Tacoma Kraft Company to WestRock CP, LLC.
2. VOC stack testing frequencies at Recovery Furnace No.4, originally required semiannually, have been revised to be required annually.
3. The incorporation of changes made to Order No. DE 01AQIS-3114 made by reference in Order No. 1916-AQ05. This includes an update to a NO_x emission algorithm.

This decision was made after review of a completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the lead agency.

This DNS is issued under WAC 197-11-340 and the comment period will end on **January 12, 2022**. This will be held concurrent to the comment period on modified NOC Order No. DE 01AQIS-3114.
