3 The 100 Area will remain an area controlled by RL for the foreseeable future. These areas will be under  
4 24-hour surveillance by Hanford Patrol protective force personnel.

5 **6.2 Barrier, Means to Control Entry, and Warning Signs**

6 No direct exposure hazards remain at 183-H Solar Evaporation Basins. However, roadways to the unit  
7 and site access will remain administratively restricted to use by authorized personnel only. Posted federal  
8 warning signs restrict access to the 100-H Area from the Columbia River.
