**Make your own bulb-storage container.**

Stick this label on an empty cardboard six-pack beverage carrier to make a nifty fluorescent-bulb holder. Pad the bottom of each compartment with a bit of wadded newspaper. Store your used bulbs until you can take them to your nearest household-hazardous-waste facility or participating retailer.

For linear fluorescent tubes, reuse the original packaging or any tall box or barrel. Stick this label on the container, and store the bulbs in a cool, dry place until you can recycle them.
