Public Comment Period for Reopened Air Operating Permit: January 21, 2009 – February 20, 2009

The Washington State Department of Ecology has reopened part of the Air Operating Permit (AOP) for Georgia Pacific, Camas. The public is encouraged to review and comment on the following reopened part of the permit:

- Condition H.12 No. 5 Power Boiler: Limit requirement of minimum steam production rate.

We must receive your written comments at our Lacey office by close of business February 20, 2009.

Facility Description

Georgia Pacific Camas Mill operates a pulp and paper mill in the City of Camas. The mill site is bound on three sides by the city. A little over a quarter of the mill site lies north of the Camas Slough (an arm of the Columbia River that connects to the Washougal River).

The mill produces pulp from both wood chips and recycled paper. Pulp from wood chips is produced using the Kraft process. The mill bleaches the pulp using an elemental chlorine free process. Pulp types are blended to create the desired products. Currently bleached kraft paper, tissue, and toweling products are produced.
