*Fuel spills have devastating impacts
on fish and wildlife.*

Boat Fueling BASICS

- Shut off all engines during fueling.
- Know the fuel capacity of your tank.
- Fill only to **90%**. Do **not** top off.
- Use an absorbent pad to catch drips.
- Avoid all distractions.

If You Spill

- Stop fueling.
- Notify the fuel or marina attendant.
- Use absorbent pads to contain and clean up the spill.
- Never use soap on spills. It is illegal and damaging.
- Call **800-OILS 911** and the U.S. Coast Guard at **800-424-8802**.
It's the law.

We ALL want to keep our local waters clean. Be careful not to spill but if you do, make the required calls. Accidents happen but if you don't report spills as required by law, you could be fined.
