### Opportunity to comment

The Department of Ecology invites you to comment on the proposed modifications to Weyerhaeuser, Longview's Air Operating Permit (AOP). We will accept comment only on the proposed changes.

We will accept comments by mail, fax or e-mail May 25, 2012 – June 25, 2012. You may request a public hearing to ask questions and submit verbal comments. To request a hearing, contact:

If we determine there is significant public interest during this comment period to hold a hearing, we will:

- Extend the comment period to allow at least 30 days notice of the hearing.
- Publish the time, date and location.

### Permit

Proposed changes to the permit include adding:

- The Longview Extruders operation purchased by Weyerhaeuser January 1, 2010.
- Amendments to the NORPAC Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) permit (PSD 97-01, Revision 3).
- Revisions to Best Available Retrofit Technology (BART) Order 7840 conditions E.1, E.7, E.10, H.12, H.14, H.17, I.4 and I.5

The Southwest Clean Air Agency (SWCAA) previously regulated the Longview Extruders operation (formerly Tetra Pak's Pacific Lamination facility). This permit modification adds the requirements and conditions from the SWCAA permit to Weyerhaeuser's AOP. There are no changes in emissions from the operation.

The NOPAC PSD revision reduces emission limits for volatile organic compounds and carbon monoxide by over 60% each.

BART Order 7840 revisions result in no changes to emissions.

This modification also administratively corrects references to applicable requirements.

When the comment period ends, we will review all comments received and make appropriate changes to the permit before issuing it.

**Facility information**

The Weyerhaeuser, Longview site includes integrated pulp and paper manufacturing facilities and lumber products manufacturing facilities. It is located at 3401 Industrial Way in Longview, Washington. Production includes:

- Wetlap pulp.
- Bleached paperboard.
- Newsprint.
- Publication papers.
- Other intermediate and finished pulp and paper products.
