The Department of Ecology (Ecology) invites you to comment on proposed Administrative Order No. 10373 for the Longview Fibre Paper and Packaging pulp and paper mill. The mill is operating as KapStone Kraft Paper Corporation.

If we determine there is significant interest during this comment period to hold a hearing, we will:

### Order

On November 5, 2013, Ecology received KapStone's application to voluntarily lower air emission limits at Recovery Furnace #18 (RF 18) and Smelt Dissolving Tank #18 (SDT 18). The mill's air operating permit allows burning of 1,200 tons of black liquor solids/day (TBLS/day), which equals 438,000 TBLS/year. This order lowers that limit for these units to burning 72,000 TBLS/year.

We expect all pollutants produced by RF 18 and SDT 18 to decrease.
