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Introduction

The Local Source Control Partnership (LSCP) began in 2008, in response to Governor Gregoire and the Washington State Legislature's Puget Sound Initiative of 2005 to restore significant urban waters. The Initiative recognized that the economic vitality and viability of the state's small businesses are critical to the overall economy and are directly tied to healthy and diverse ecosystems that have their basis in clean water.

This report details the ongoing progress of the LSCP in the 2011-2013 biennium (July 1, 2011 – June 30, 2013). The Department of Ecology (Ecology) works with partners in the Puget Sound and Spokane River watersheds. These partners deliver technical assistance to the doorsteps of small businesses.

Summary

In the 2011-2013 biennium, Ecology had 24 LSCP partner jurisdictions. Each jurisdiction hires one or more Local Source Control (LSC) Specialist and is under contract to deliver on site, no-charge technical assistance visits to small businesses within their jurisdiction. The Specialists completed 6,276 total site visits in the biennium.

The on-site visits address possible causes of pollution at the business site. Many of the estimated 75,000 small businesses in Washington State typically have limited access to hazardous waste handling, disposal, and stormwater management expertise.

Small businesses are usually classified as Small Quantity Generators (SQGs). SQGs produce less than 220 pounds of dangerous waste or less than 2.2 pounds of acutely hazardous waste on site per month.


Site visits are recorded in a designated Ecology database. They provide an expanded view of the waste management and stormwater issues small businesses face. Details and statistics about each partner's LSCP work are in Appendix A.

Local Source Control Specialists look closely at business practices. They offer solutions and alternatives to the hazardous materials that are used, stored, and disposed of by each business. Specialists draw on local and Ecology regional office staff expertise for the numerous issues and types of waste encountered. The aim is to help businesses make changes to limit or eliminate potential pollution from the business site and contribute towards improved water quality.

Budget and Staffing

Every biennium since program inception, the LSC Specialists have exceeded the number of contracted site visits, reflecting efficiency gained over the five years that the program has been in existence.

- Ten of 25 partner jurisdictions had less than full time funding in 2011-13.
- The Washington Legislature provided additional state funds of \$1,000,000 in 2011-13 for LSC. Of this, approximately \$900,000 was used for new partners and \$100,000 for a new database. Four new partners were also added during the 2011-13 biennium through additional funds from a National Estuary Program (NEP) grant. These new partners were the Cities of Everett, Puyallup, Port Angeles, and Bothell.
- Two jurisdictions were, by agreement, doing source control site visits in other, adjacent jurisdictions.
 - King County Department of Natural Resources and Parks took over the City of Newcastle LSC work. Tacoma-Pierce County Health Department agreed to complete site visits in seven nearby municipalities.
- Our one Eastern Washington partner is the Spokane Regional Health District. They are focused on specific areas within the Spokane River watershed.

Program Results

In the 2011-2013 biennium, LSC Specialists conducted 6,276 site visits to businesses in 96 different business sectors. These visits were in eight of the ten counties surrounding Puget Sound and in concentrated sections of the Spokane River watershed.

Partner jurisdictions do everything possible to resolve pollution problems locally. If that is not successful, the business is usually referred to Ecology.

There were 255 referrals made by the Specialists, representing four percent of total site visits.

Of the 96 sectors visited, the top five are detailed below, including the number of issues found per visit. These five sectors made up over 55 percent of businesses visited and 56 percent of all issues found. This information aids in targeting particular sectors and in allocating resources to carry out the work.

Combined with the top five sectors, the next 18 sectors comprise about 80 percent of the issues found during 2011-2013. The top 23.5 percent of all industries represent 80 percent of the site visit problems found by the LSC Specialists.

Issues Found and Resolved

There were 5,913 total issues found during 2011-2013 and 91 percent of these were found during initial site visits. During return visits, another eight percent, or 487 issues, were discovered. Of the businesses visited, 25 percent, or 1,077 had no issues found. Specialists found issues at 75 percent of businesses visited.

The average time to resolve these problems is 62 days. There were 4,399 (74 percent) issues resolved during the biennium. The remaining issues are pending. (Pending issues are issues that were not resolved by the end of the biennium.)

Changes in Business Practices

As a result of LSC site visits:

- Toxics used in business processes are being reduced or replaced with safer alternatives.
- Business site housekeeping has significantly improved in many cases.
- Safer materials handling and storage is being adopted.
- Businesses are increasingly aware of and managing their interior and exterior drainage systems for reduced impacts to stormwater.
- Businesses are eagerly adopting spill preparedness.

A new LSCP database was launched in April 2013. It allows us to record businesses' changes and investments in pollution prevention. Businesses correcting their management practices means:

- The on-site work being accomplished is effective.
- There are potential positive impacts to the surface water of each local jurisdiction.

LSC 'at the doorstep' expertise ultimately leads to cost savings realized through:

- Increased business efficiency
- Conservation of materials and resources
- Improved worker safety
- Spill preparedness
- Avoided costs of cleanup

These savings can lead to an increased competitive advantage for businesses, which is an incentive to invest in these practices.

Spill Kits and Secondary Containment

In this biennium, the program assembled and distributed spill kits to each partner. Partners distributed the kits to businesses that were willing to prepare a simple spill prevention plan, train employees, and post emergency contact numbers.

Since 2010, 1,447 kits were distributed. They are popular with businesses that were not prepared for a spill or aware of the cost savings in preventing pollution rather than cleanup. The LSCP is currently investigating options to provide spill kits on an as-needed basis.

LSCP is also finalizing separate partner agreements to reimburse purchases of secondary containment equipment. Businesses are asked to pay 25 percent of any containment equipment. LSCP funds reimburse 75 percent of the cost, up to a maximum of \$225 per business. This is funded through an EPA – NEP grant.

The program will allow each partner jurisdiction to provide up to 21 businesses with secondary containment.

Specialist Training

LSC requires proficiency in handling many different types of wastes and processes. This presents a challenge in keeping up with best management practices. There has been a 40 percent turnover in Specialists since program inception.

Ecology provides ongoing monthly trainings with guest speakers through webinars and conference calls. Experienced Specialists are asked to mentor new Specialists and are required to contribute to the development and planning of their own quarterly in-person trainings. All LSC Specialists have access to Ecology staff expertise, leading to a broad system of information exchange and an enhanced level of assistance.

Partner Highlights 2011-2013 Biennium

City of Bellingham

- Conducted sector-specific and door-to-door visits to all businesses within two blocks of the downtown area to identify specific water quality concerns.
- Initiated collaborative work with city fire department to conduct site visits together. This improved interdepartmental communication and understanding.
- Wrote and revised Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plans for City of Bellingham Public Works and Parks Operations facilities.
- Continued to work closely with Take Back Your Meds coalition and other jurisdictions to understand and interpret pharmaceutical regulations, in order to present consistent information to businesses affected by these regulations.

City of Bothell

- Sectors visited: auto body, service, and sales, golf course management, school district facilities, restaurants and coffee stands, dentistry, misc. medical supply facilities.
- Contained 810 - 1,075 gallons of hazardous waste.
- Delivered spill kits to 53 businesses completing a spill plan.
- Developed "The Spill Book," a resource booklet with information on spill preparedness and response, sector best management practices, hazardous waste disposal, and regulatory compliance.

Clallam County

- Mentored City of Port Angeles Local Source Control Specialist.
- Conducted peer training.
- All visits to dry cleaners are completed. Started visits to gas stations.

City of Everett

- Visited automotive businesses.

City of Issaquah

- Placed 1,636 gallons of hazardous materials within secondary containment.
- Removed 220 gallons of hazardous materials from a business that did not need it.
- Corrected stormwater quality related issues at roughly 20 businesses.
- Detected illicit connections or illicit discharges.
- Equipped 6 businesses with spill supplies.

Jefferson County Public Health

- Sector site visits to Marine Trades Industry continues as a high-priority due to toxics generated (copper, zinc, and other heavy metals) with close proximity to Port Townsend Bay (550 feet).
- High concentration of businesses located within 500 feet of Port Townsend Bay.
- High-turnover of employees makes education and outreach challenging.

King County Water & Land (includes City of Newcastle)

- Distributed 50 spill kits to Small Quantity Generators.
- Presented to the Chamber of Commerce in Maple Valley.
- Initiated and developed Memorandum of Understanding to conduct LSCP activities within incorporated areas that do not have the resources to launch and maintain a LSC Specialist (Cities of Kirkland, Kent, Federal Way, Auburn, and Maple Valley in King County)
- Adopted the 19 remaining site visits for the City of Newcastle.

Kitsap County Health District

- Focused on follow-up visits in last quarter.
- Visited all businesses sectors.

Kitsap County Public Works (includes Mason County)

- Increased Mason County visits to ~13% in 2011-2013; additional follow-up visits have also been conducted.
- Provided approximately 75 spill kits to businesses, including 26 to automotive-related businesses.

City of Marysville

- Visited approximately 95% of auto shops, 46% of restaurants, and 100% of dry cleaners.
- Achieved voluntary compliance to remedy several problems, including:
 - Dry cleaner improperly evaporating PERC distiller water.
 - Floor drains improperly connected to stormwater system.
 - Tire wash water discharging to stormwater system.
 - Auto detail business washing cars into storm system.
 - Clothes washer used to wash shop rags improperly piped to greenbelt.
 - Restaurant improperly storing waste grease in a kiddie pool.

City of Port Angeles

- Sectors visited: food service establishments (62%), auto/engine repair (29%), dentists (7%), and miscellaneous (2%).
- Completed nine illicit discharge detection and elimination (IDDE) investigations, including comprehensive education and follow up.
- Placed eight storm drain labels adjacent to visited businesses.

Port of Seattle

- Completed all contracted site visits to SQG businesses at port locations.

City of Puyallup

- Focused on restaurants; identified 43 imminent illicit discharge conditions and 21 imminent pretreatment system failures.
- Expanded Puyallup's Storm Drain Marking program to included private property storm drains.
- Developed 12 customized reference documents for the restaurant industry.
- Created demonstration video on Puyallup's Fish-Friendly Car Wash kits, explaining environmental benefits.

City of Redmond

- Contained 2,456 gallons of hazardous materials.
- Removed and disposed of 925 gallons of hazardous materials.
- Resolved high priority environmental issues at 33 sites.
- Delivered spill kits to 11 businesses after completion and posting of spill procedures.

San Juan County

- Worked with County Derelict Vessel Program on storage and disposal of hazardous materials from seized vessels.
- Delivered seven presentations on LSC and stormwater topics to Regional State Park Managers, County Park staff, staff at local marine service provider business, and a junior high class (stormwater education).
- Contacted over 85 businesses to inform them about once-yearly hazardous waste collection.
- Partnered with San Juan Prevention Coalition and Sheriff's office to promote collection of unwanted medications and other drugs; permanent collection boxes are now installed in 3 Sheriff's offices and 3 pharmacies.

Seattle Public Utilities

- 59 audits.
- 29 audits with a minority community focus.
- 195 inspections.
- 239 follow-up visits.

City of Sedro-Woolley

- Great response in cleanup and maintenance of various site components:
 - Materials Storage
 - Containment and drainage
 - Materials handling and waste disposal

City of Shoreline

- Provided best management practices information to 39 gas stations and auto repair facilities.
- Achieved substantial improvements to auto repair facility with an immediate threat to water quality.
 - Removed polluting and toxic materials from an outside area.
 - Discovered original oil-water separator had been improperly filled with concrete.

Skagit County Public Health

- Targeted businesses in Gages Slough and Joe Leary Slough in Burlington and South Mount Vernon.
- Began inspecting the Restaurant sector after consultation and support from Publically Owned Treatment Works (POTW) operators.
- Worked on best management practices with county commercial car wash facilities.
- Developed a city-specific best practices poster for charity car washes.

Snohomish Health District

- Assisted the city of Lynnwood where we initiated the LSC program visits.
- Edmonds' Waste Water Treatment plant requested LSC help when they realized that their sewage sludge would exceed new stringent limits set by EPA for mercury.
- Avoided \$6 million in upgrades through visits to dental offices.
- Resulted in 100% compliance in amalgam (mercury) waste management for all dentists in their service area, an increase from less than half before commencing campaign.

Spokane Regional Health District

- Sectors visited: auto repair, auto collision repair, used tire dealers, used auto dealers, gas stations, dry cleaners, veterinarian, chiropractor, appliance repair, manufacturers, photographers, window manufacturers, breweries, car/truck washes and detailers, home repair, property managers, engine repair, furniture builders, refinishers and re-upholsterers, bottling company, transport companies, tire re-treading company, fuel depot, construction companies, high tech electronic manufacturers, injection molding, metal cutting, electronics repair, screen printers, printers, paint companies, machine shops, roofing companies, carpet cleaners, plumbing, electrical & HVAC contractors, lawn and garden centers, landscapers, and schools.

City of Sumner

- Prioritized businesses in Stormwater Management Area.
- Visited general warehousing, greenhouse/nursery, dry cleaners, auto detail shops, and orthodontists.

Tacoma Pierce County Health District (including Bonney Lake, DuPont, Edgewood, Fife, Fircrest, Gig Harbor, Pacific)

- Provided service to 391 unique business locations.
- Completed ongoing sector-specific work targeting golf courses.
- Conducted new work in targeted business sectors, including gas stations, hardware/home improvement centers, school transportation services, veterinary clinics, chiropractic offices, and photo labs.
- Targeted all SQG businesses along a major highway or business district).
- Emphasized work in automotive-related businesses and/or food service establishments.

Whatcom County Health District

- Helped promote Puget Sound Vehicle Leaks education campaign with the City of Bellingham.
- Distributed 50 spill kits to select businesses in Whatcom County.
- Focused on marina, landscaping, nursery, and fuel station sectors, in addition to conducting site visits across other industry sectors.
- Completed site visits for an entire industrial park served by a shared, on-site sewage system.
