## Comment opportunity

The Department of Ecology (Ecology) invites you to comment on the proposed Air Operating Permit renewal for Georgia Pacific Consumer Products (Camas) L.L.C.

We will accept comments by mail, fax and e-mail March 10 – April 11, 2014.

## Permit

Proposed changes to the permit include:

- Updates to conditions K, S, and U and section T
- Removal of conditions and bubble mass emissions related to equipment permanently shut down since the last permit issuance. Overall renumbering of conditions reflects this change.
- Added new conditions for:
  - Greenhouse gas reporting requirements.
  - Emergency reciprocating internal combustion engines installed and operated onsite.

More information on these changes is available on page 48 of the permit's statement of basis.
