Errata Sheet for Water Quality Standards for Surface Waters of the State of Washington, Chapter 173-201A WAC

A correction was made to the following versions of Chapter 173-201A WAC, the Surface Water Quality Standards (SWQS):

The error was in WAC 173-201A-200(ii)(A), stating “Incremental temperature increases resulting from individual point source activities must not, at any time, exceed **28/(T)** as measured at the edge of a mixing zone boundary...”

The correct text reads “Incremental temperature increases resulting from individual point source activities must not, at any time, exceed **28/(T+7)** as measured at the edge of a mixing zone boundary...”

The legal codified version of WAC 173-201A, maintained by the Code Reviser’s Office in a database, shows the text correctly as **28/(T+7)**.

The error occurred when the Code Reviser’s office posted the codified text to the Washington State Legislature web page (<http://apps.leg.wa.gov/WAC/default.aspx?cite=173-201A>). The formula for incremental temperature increase was posted as $28/T$ instead of $28/(T+7)$. The error was carried forward because Ecology used the Washington State Legislature webpage text to update Ecology’s “easy to read” version of the Standards (publication #06-10-091).

The error was corrected in the electronic versions of the rule on the legislative website and Ecology’s publication website.
