Delisting from Hazardous Sites List

Ecology is proposing to remove four schools in the city of Wenatchee: Lewis and Clark Elementary, ranked a 3, Lincoln Elementary, ranked a 3, Washington Elementary, ranked a 3; and West Side High School, ranked a 4, from the Hazardous Sites List. Sites can be ranked from "1" to "5". A rank of "1" is the highest level of environmental concern compared to other sites on the list, and a rank of "5" is the lowest.

All four sites were former orchards and subjected to historical pesticide applications. Lead arsenate was widely used to control the codling moth prior to 1950. As a result, lead arsenate has contaminated many former orchards throughout central Washington. In 2002, Ecology tested the soil and found lead

and arsenic contamination exceeding state cleanup levels.

During the summer of 2006, Ecology staff managed cleanups at all four sites. These cleanups used excavation, deep mixing, or a combination of the two, to reduce or eliminate the lead and arsenic contamination.

Generally, soil with arsenic levels above 100 parts per million (ppm) was excavated prior to deep mixing. Then the contaminated soil was disposed of at the Greater Wenatchee Landfill. Once excavation was complete, deep mixing could take place. This involves mixing the contaminated soil with clean soil from beneath the contamination. This is very effective in reducing lead and arsenic concentrations throughout the soil profile.

Once the deep mixing was complete, clean topsoil was imported and new seed or sod was placed down to establish grass. All sites were restored to their original condition.

Ecology staff verified through confirmational sampling that the contamination had been either removed or reduced to below state cleanup levels. Therefore, Ecology proposes removing the four sites from the Hazardous Sites list. They no longer pose a threat to human health and the environment.

Agreed Order

An Agreed Order and associated Public Participation Plan for the Custom Plywood Mill site in Anacortes, WA are available for public comment. The Agreed Order requires the Concorde Inc. to conduct a Remedial Investigation and Feasibility Study (RI/FS) and to develop a Cleanup Action Plan and Public Participation Plan for the site. Petroleum hydrocarbons in the gasoline and heavy oil ranges, arsenic, cadmium, chromium, lead, and polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs) have exceeded Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA) soil cleanup levels at the site. Contamination of groundwater and sediment is also possible. The site was used to operate a sawmill, which included a box factory and planning mill. Later, under various owners from the early 1900s until 1992, it operated as a plywood mill.

Agreed Order

An Agreed Order and associated Public Participation Plan for the JELD WEN, Inc. site in Everett, WA are available for public comment. The Agreed Order requires JELD WEN, Inc. to conduct a Remedial Investigation and Feasibility Study (RI/FS) and develop a Cleanup Action Plan for the site. A Public Participation Plan is also required for the site.

Concentrations of total petroleum hydrocarbons (TPH), polynuclear aromatic hydrocarbons (PAHs), and toluene exceed Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA) cleanup levels in soil and groundwater, and benzene concentrations exceed MTCA cleanup levels in groundwater. Pentachlorophenol (PCP) and polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs) have also been used on the site.

A wooden door plant with a machine shop that manufactured parts, and a pole treating yard, formerly occupied the site.

Agreed Order for a Remedial Investigation and Feasibility Study

Ecology proposes to enter into an Agreed Order with Bojo Investments, LLC (Bojo Investments), one of the potentially liable parties, to complete a Remedial Investigation and Feasibility Study at the Reliable Steel Fabricators site in Olympia. Contamination resulted from steel tank, vessel and beam manufacturing activities from 1941 until present. Investigations discovered heavy metals and solvents at the site at levels above Model Toxics Cleanup Act cleanup standards.

In addition, underground storage tanks on site may also have resulted in the release of petroleum hydrocarbons to the site.

The Agreed Order would require Bojo Investments to:

- Conduct a Remedial investigation (RI) to determine the nature and extent of contamination on site.
- Complete a Feasibility study (FS) to develop and evaluate cleanup alternatives.

When a property owner applies to Ecology for review of their independent cleanup, the site enters the Voluntary Cleanup Program. After review, Ecology sends a letter to the property owner stating either that additional work is required to be removed from the list of hazardous waste sites or that no further action is needed.
