The alternative preferred by Ecology consists primarily of placing clean soil on top of the existing soil, and establishing new grass on this clean soil. Ecology has determined that this alternative will provide the necessary barrier to prevent human exposure to the contaminants.

After reviewing the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) environmental checklist, Ecology has determined that the cleanup action will not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment and an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) is not required.

Soil beneath the grass on the playground at the school is contaminated with lead

and arsenic. The contamination likely comes from the use of these chemicals as orchard pest sprays in the early and mid 20th century. Sampling and analysis indicate that contamination exceeds state cleanup levels for lead and arsenic.

The alternative preferred by Ecology at both schools consists primarily of placing clean soil on top of the existing soil, and establishing new grass on this clean soil. Ecology has determined that this alternative will provide the necessary barrier to prevent human exposure to the contaminants. At each school, the plan includes modification of the existing irrigation system to maintain the turf grass cover.

After reviewing the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) environmental checklist, Ecology has determined that the cleanup action will not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment and an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) is not required.

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### Port Angeles Harbor Sediments Investigation, Port Angeles

**Public comment period:**  
**4/28/08 – 5/29/08**

*Draft Sampling and Analysis Plan Available for Public Comment*

Ecology is planning a study of pollution in the sediments of Port Angeles Harbor. Past sediment sampling has shown that levels of several toxic chemicals exceed state cleanup standards. These chemicals include poly-aromatic hydrocarbons (PAHs), wood debris, dioxins, furans, and polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs).

This study will look at:

- Gaps in our current understanding of pollution in the harbor.
- The nature and extent of pollution in harbor sediments.
- How sediments and bottom currents move throughout the harbor.
- "Fingerprinting" pollutants to determine where they came from.
- The human health and ecological risk of the contaminants of highest concern.

Port Angeles Harbor is one of several Puget Sound bays being targeted for priority cleanup by the Puget Sound Initiative. Ecology is using special funding from this initiative to investigate sediment pollution and develop a strategy for cleaning up the harbor.

Soil beneath the grass located at the northeast corner of the playfield at the school is contaminated with lead and arsenic. The contamination likely comes from the use of these chemicals as orchard pest sprays in the early and mid 20th century. Sampling and analysis indicate that contamination exceeds state cleanup levels for lead and arsenic.

Ecology has considered several alternatives for cleanup. The alternative preferred by Ecology at the school consists primarily of placing an asphalt cap on top of the existing soil. Ecology has determined that this alternative will provide the necessary barrier to prevent human exposure to the contaminants.

After reviewing the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) environmental checklist, Ecology has determined that the cleanup action will not have a probable significant adverse impact on

the environment and an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) is not required.

### *Proposed Consent Decree*

Ecology proposes a consent decree with BSB Diversified Company, Inc. for the BSB property (Parcel G). The consent decree requires BSB to install a slurry wall around and a cap over, all of the Property and gradient control within the Property containment area using zero valent iron (ZVI) reactor vessels. The slurry wall would prevent groundwater from passing into the contaminated area, the cap would minimize surface water infiltration, and the ZVI reactor vessels would destroy contaminants in the groundwater that is allowed to exit the containment cell by directing it through the ZVI reactor vessels. BSB has residual

concentrations of vinyl chloride, cis 1,2 dichloroethene, and trichloroethene in excess of Model Toxics Control Act Cleanup Level(s) in soil and groundwater. BSB is currently a 4.2-acre fenced, vacant lot. A metal finishing/electroplating plant and a composites plant formerly operated on the BSB and neighboring Hexcel properties. BSB (Parcel G), housed impoundments, lagoons, container storage, and similar units for managing waste, including hazardous waste, through storage and disposal. The wastes contained in some of these units included chlorinated compounds. Waste management activities and associated releases of hazardous substances were investigated and cleanup actions initiated.

Ecology is entering into an Agreed Order with USG Interiors Inc. (USG) to investigate and clean up the USG Puyallup site. The site sits on the banks of the Puyallup River. Before 1983, USG used the site to dispose of waste from their rock wool manufacturing plant in Tacoma. There is known arsenic contamination in soil and groundwater.

- Conduct a Remedial Investigation to determine the extent and nature of pollution at the site
- Complete a Feasibility Study to evaluate possible cleanup actions

### *Agreed Order*

An Agreed Order and associated Public Participation Plan for the Shell Oil Tank Farm Site in Anacortes, WA are available for public comment. The Agreed Order requires the Port of Anacortes to conduct a Remedial Investigation and Feasibility Study (RI/FS) and to develop a Public Participation Plan and Draft Cleanup Action Plan for the Site. The Shell Oil Tank Farm was a distribution facility for gasoline, diesel, oil and other chemical products.

Leaking above-ground storage tanks resulted in the release of petroleum hydrocarbons, including gasoline, diesel, and heavy oil. This contamination has been found in soil and groundwater. Gasoline, diesel, heavy oil, and cadmium contamination in soil samples has been found to exceed Model Toxics Control Act cleanup levels. Soil was removed from the Site in 1987 and 2007; however, the amount of remaining contamination is unknown.

### *Agreed Order*

An Agreed Order and associated Public Participation Plan for the North Marina West End Site in Everett, WA, are available for public comment. The Agreed Order requires the port of Everett to conduct a Remedial Investigation and Feasibility Study (RI/FS), develop a Public Participation Plan and a draft Cleanup Action Plan for the Site. The North Marina West End Site was used for marine and general industrial purposes such as trucking, welding, sandblasting, and painting. The Site also contained a number of storage tanks for diesel fuel, gasoline, and oil. Polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons (PAHs), petroleum hydrocarbons, and five (5) metals have been found to exceed Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA) cleanup levels in soil. Two (2) metals, vinyl chloride and petroleum hydrocarbons, exceed MTCA cleanup levels in groundwater. One PAH (acenaphthene) exceeds its respective Sediment Quality Standard (SQS) in sediment. The port has completed significant investigation and partial cleanup of this Site as part of a larger North Marina Redevelopment project known as Port Gardner Wharf. Ecology is working with the port to complete this investigation and cleanup.

*Proposed Removal from Hazardous Sites List*

Ecology proposes to remove Reid's Automotive from the Hazardous Sites List. The site, formerly Art's Auto Doctors, was primarily operated as an auto repair facility since it was developed in 1975. Soil contamination was discovered in 2002. Petroleum hydrocarbons were detected above MTCA standards. An underground storage tank was also discovered on site. It contained oily water and had contaminated the surrounding soil. No

evidence of groundwater contamination was found.

A site hazard assessment was conducted in 2005 and the site was ranked a two (one represents the highest relative risk and a five the lowest relative risk). The site was then listed on the Hazardous Sites List. Reid Automotive entered the Voluntary Cleanup Program in 2007. Cleanup activities at the site included excavation of gasoline and heavy oil range hydrocarbon contaminated soil and removal of an underground storage tank and its piping.

Reid's Automotive submitted an Interim Remediation report documenting cleanup efforts at the site. An Ecology site manager reviewed the report and determined that:

- The site is no longer a threat to human health or the environment.
- The cleanup actions at the site meet MTCA standards.
- No further action is needed.

#### *Negotiations for an Agreed Order*

Ecology and the Port of Olympia have begun negotiations for an Agreed Order to complete a Remedial Investigation and conduct an Interim Action at the East Bay Redevelopment site in Olympia. The site has been used for timber-related industries from the late 1880s until 1968. From 1968 to present, the site has been used for commercial and light industrial activities and storage. Historic activities at the site resulted in contamination of soil and groundwater. Total petroleum hydrocarbons, polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons, dioxins and furans and metals were detected at levels above MTCA standards.

The Port of Olympia entered the Voluntary Cleanup Program in January 2007. To expedite the cleanup for future developments and to ensure Ecology oversight, the site was transferred into the formal cleanup program in February 2008.

#### *Negotiations for an Agreed Order*

Ecology and the City of Olympia have begun negotiations for an Agreed Order

to complete a Remedial Investigation and Feasibility Study, conduct an Interim Action and prepare a draft Cleanup Action Plan for the Solid Wood Inc. site in Olympia. Past operations at the site resulted in the contamination of soil, groundwater, and possibly sediment. Initial investigations discovered total petroleum hydrocarbons (TPH), polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons (PAH) and metals at levels that exceed the Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA) cleanup standards in soil or groundwater.

The site has been purchased by the City of Olympia for development as a waterfront park. The City is now responsible for the cleanup of contamination at the site. Cleanup and development of the first phase of the West Bay Waterfront Park will occur this summer.
