UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK OWNER/OPERATOR INFORMATION DOCUMENTS

When opening a new Underground Storage Tank (UST) facility, or changing ownership of a current UST site, the **Master Business Application** and the **Underground Storage Tank Addendum** are required to be completed and returned to the Department of Licensing. Payment of fees and proof of financial responsibility are also required.

Summary of Requirements for Underground Storage Tanks discusses the minimum requirements for complying with UST regulations.

If you intend to install or permanently close an UST, submittal of a **30 Day Notice Form** to the Department of Ecology is required.
