If Ecology determines there is significant public interest during this comment period to hold a hearing, we will extend the comment period to allow at least 30 days notice of the hearing and publish the time, date and location.

## Changes to Order 1908-AQ05

Changes in this order apply to opacity monitoring at the No. 10 recovery boiler. The opacity limit for the boiler will remain the same. Only the proposed changes are open for comment. All changes are located in Table A, condition A.1. These include:

- Removing the continuous sampling frequency requirement.
- Replacing 40 CFR Part 60, Appendix B, Spec. 1 with EPA Reference Method 9 (RM9).

A continuous opacity monitoring system (COMS) is currently used to monitor opacity. Water droplets are interfering with the COMS and 40 CFR part 60, appendix B prohibits use of a COMS when there is water droplet interference.

**Order history**

The original order was issued in August 2005. Ecology gave the public an opportunity to request a comment period on this change, running for 15 days December 8 – 28, 2010. We received a request to hold this formal comment period.

**Facility description**

The Kimberly-Clark mill is located at 2600 Federal Avenue, Everett, WA. Primary products are sulfite pulp, tissue paper and other paper products. They employ about 850 employees.
