## State Waste Discharge Permit

The Department of Ecology invites you to comment on the proposed new State Waste Discharge Permit (SWDP) for Hasa, Inc.

We will accept comments by mail, fax or e-mail August 26, 2011 – September 26, 2011. You may request a public hearing to ask questions and submit verbal comments. To request a hearing, contact:

If we determine there is significant public interest during this comment period to hold a hearing, we will:

- Extend the comment period to allow at least 30 days notice of the hearing.
- Publish the time, date and location.

### Permit

Once the plant is operational, industrial wastewater will discharge to Weyerhaeuser Longview's wastewater treatment facility. After treatment there, Weyerhaeuser will discharge it to outfall 001/002 on the Columbia River.

A SWDP is normally issued every 5 years. It:

- Sets limits on the kinds, amounts, and concentrations of pollutants a facility may release.
- Requires a facility to measure, test, and report its pollutants.
- Prescribes "best management practices".
- Defines the pollution control standards applied.

**Facility information**

Hasa Inc. plans to operate a sodium hypochlorite (bleach) re-packaging plant at 3400 Industrial Way in Longview. The facility plans to receive bleach in bulk tank trucks, off-load to bulk storage tanks, and repackage it into one-gallon bottles.
