Draft Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study and Other Documents Available for Public Comment

Ecology invites you to review and comment on the following documents for the Custom Plywood Mill Site in Anacortes: Draft Remedial Investigation (RI)/Feasibility Study (FS); Draft Cleanup Action Plan (CAP) and Engineering Design Report for the upland cleanup; and State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) Checklist and Mitigated Determination of Non-Significance (DNS).

The RI describes the nature and extent of contamination in upland soil and groundwater, and sediments in the in-water portions of the Site. The FS identifies possible cleanup options for the upland and in-water portions of the Site and selects the preferred option for each. The Draft CAP and Engineering Design Report describe the cleanup in detail. The SEPA Checklist and Mitigated DNS indicate that the cleanup option is unlikely to have significant negative environmental impacts. The Public Participation Plan has also been updated.

Ecology is updating the CLARC Web Application

The CLARC web application is being updated to reflect current toxicity values. CLARC is a web application tool developed by Ecology that uses the equations and default input parameters in the MTCA Cleanup Regulation to calculate cleanup levels. (CLARC stands for “Cleanup Level and Risk Calculations.”) This tool is intended to help Ecology site managers and others gather the information needed to set cleanup standards and make decisions according to the requirements in the regulation. To remain useful as a tool, CLARC needs to reflect current toxicity information. Ecology expects the update to be complete in March, 2011.

Draft Guidance for Remediation of Petroleum Contaminated Sites Now Available for Review

Ecology recently completed a draft guidance document for remediation of petroleum contaminated sites. The draft document addresses issues and questions on the requirements for investigating and cleaning up petroleum contaminated sites under the current Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA) Cleanup Regulation. The draft guidance document is now available for review on the Ecology web site under “Policies and Guidance.” http://www.ecy.wa.gov/programs/tcp/policies/pol_main.html

This draft guidance is intended to update and replace previous guidance issued in November, 1995 (Ecology publication 91-30). While it won't answer every question that comes up at petroleum contaminated sites, we think it will help considerably. Ecology will accept comments on the draft guidance through March 18, 2011. We will review all comments and then make appropriate changes before finalizing the document next year.

This draft guidance makes a number of major changes from that earlier guidance. These changes were made in response to implementation questions that people have raised as they investigate and cleanup petroleum releases.

- We increased the scope of the guidance to address all types of petroleum contaminated sites and media, not just releases from underground storage tanks to soils.
- The updates reflect changes in regulations since the 1995 guidance was published.
- The updated guidance provides more information on release reporting, site characterization, establishing cleanup levels, and measuring compliance with cleanup levels.
- Permit-related information has been updated.
- The updated guidance includes new guidelines regarding the re-use of petroleum contaminated soil.

GLOSSARY

Agreed Order - A legal agreement with Ecology to make sure the cleanup meets the standards of Washington State's cleanup law, the Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA).

Cleanup Action Plan (CAP) - A document that describes the selected cleanup method(s) and specifies cleanup standards and other requirements. It is based on information and technical analyses generated during the RI/FS and consideration of public comments and community concerns. A draft of the CAP (DCAP) is made available for public review and comment before finalizing.

Comment Period - A time period during which the public can review and comment on various documents and Ecology or EPA actions. For example, a comment period is provided to allow community members to review and comment on proposed cleanup action alternatives and proposed plans. Also, a comment period is held to allow community members to review and comment on draft feasibility studies.

Consent Decree - A formal legal agreement that is filed with a court. It describes studies and/or cleanup work to be done at a site and the terms under which that work is to be done.

Engineering Design Report - Engineering design reports outline the specific details for implementation and operation of the first phase of the cleanup actions.

ERTS - Environmental Response Tracking System

Five Year Periodic Review - A periodic review is conducted at least every five years after the initiation of a cleanup action at a site, as required by the Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA). The purposes of the review are to evaluate site conditions, after cleanup is considered complete, and to ensure protection of human health and the environment.

Hazardous Sites List - A statewide list of contaminated properties. Ecology may remove a site from the list only after determining that all remedial actions except confirmational monitoring have been completed and compliance with the cleanup standards has been achieved at the site, or the listing was erroneous.

Independent Cleanup Action - Any remedial action without department oversight or approval and not under an order or decree

LUST - Leaking Underground Storage Tank

NFA - No Further Action

PSI - Puget Sound Initiative

Publication Participation Plan - Outlines and describes the tools Ecology will use to inform the public about site activities, and it identifies opportunities for the community to become involved in this process.

RCW - Revised Code of Washington

Remedial Action - Construction work done to clean up a contaminated site.

Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study - Two distinct but related studies. They are usually performed at the same time, and together referred to as the "RI/FS."

Responsiveness Summary - A summary of oral and/or written public comments received by Ecology during a comment period on key documents, and Ecology's responses to those comments.

RI/FS - See Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study

SEPA - State Environmental Policy Act

SHA, Site Hazard Assessment - An assessment to gather information about a site to confirm whether a release of hazardous substances has occurred and to enable Ecology to evaluate the relative potential hazard posed by the release.

UST - Underground Storage Tank

UXO - Unexploded Ordnance

VCP - Voluntary Cleanup Program

Voluntary Cleanup Program (VCP) - The VCP is one of several options for cleaning up a hazardous waste site under the state's cleanup law. Under this option, property owners may perform a cleanup independently and request services from Ecology for a fee.

WAC - Washington Administrative Code

WARM, Washington Ranking Method - The method used to rank sites placed on the Hazardous Sites List
