The Department of Ecology invites you to comment on Longview Fibre Paper and Packaging, Inc.'s Notice of Construction (NOC) Order No. 9213 and State Environmental Policy Act Determination of Nonsignificance.

NOC Order No. 9213

The proposed order allows the mill to make modifications improving performance and efficiency of Paper Machine Numbers 5, 7, 10, 11, and 12. After the modifications, the maximum hourly production rates of the five machines will increase by an average of 4%. The current mill daily average production limit will remain in effect after completion of the project.

Expected emission rate increases include:

- Maximum hourly particulate matter (PM), PM10 and PM2.5 by 0.17 lb/hr; and volatile organic compounds by 1.05 lb/hr.
- Toxic air pollutants within acceptable state criteria levels.

The proposed order also includes operating limits and other requirements the mill must meet.

Facility description

The mill is located at 300 Fibre Way near Longview and began operation in 1927. Products include bag, kraft, wrapping and specialty papers and containerboard. The mill employs about 1,000 people and average production is approximately 3,000 tons per day.
