## **Ecology Approves Changes for Hanford's Dangerous Waste Permit**

The Washington State Department of Ecology has approved a "Class 2" modification for the permit that regulates the treatment, storage, and disposal of dangerous wastes at Hanford.

Class 2 changes are those that are significant enough to require the permittee to hold a public comment period and a public meeting. (The permittee is the U.S. Department of Energy.)

This Class 2 permit change is for the 242-A Evaporator chapter of the permit. The evaporator reduces the volume of tank waste to create more space in the double-shell tank system.

The changes address the tank waste sampling approach in the Waste Analysis Plan, and preparedness and prevention measures.

Ecology's decisions, including approval of this permit change, can be appealed through the steps in Washington Administrative Code 173-303-845.
