

Check Your Dangerous Waste Accumulation Area

COVERED AREA

Prevent rainwater from filling up secondary containment.

PROPER SIGNS

Use appropriate warning signs for the area.

PHONE

Keep a communication device nearby in case of emergencies.

FIRE PROTECTION

Keep a fire extinguisher nearby.



SPILL KIT

Keep a spill kit within the area.

SEGREGATE WASTES

Incompatible wastes need to be in a different area to avoid fire or explosion.

SECONDARY CONTAINMENT

Must contain 10% of the free liquid in all containers or 100% of the free liquid in the largest container, whichever is larger.

AISLE SPACE

Leave at least 30" of aisle space between rows of drums. Rows must be no more than two drums wide.

VISIBLE LABELS

All labels must be readable without having to move materials.
