On December 10, 1974 two water samples were taken from Olequa Creek immediately below the two Shakertown Corporation plants at Winlock, Washington. Along with other water quality parameters, an analysis for phenols was done. The concentrations of phenols were .006 and .001 PPM (parts per million) which is at the very threshold of detection limits. Since the samples were taken at a time of heavy rain it seems logical that leaching from Shakertown's waste water ponds next to Olequa Creek would be near a maximum. Therefore, at that moment, it seems that Shakertown has negligible effect on the quality of Olequa Creek as far as phenols are concerned.
