To Continue/Obtain Coverage Under the General Permit for Biosolids Management

You must complete and submit this form by February 21st, 2015.

The current *General Permit for Biosolids Management* (General Permit) expires on August 20, 2015. You must submit this *Notice of Intent* form no less than 180 days before the expiration date (February 21, 2015) according to [WAC 173-308-310\(5\)\(a\)](#). When submitted as required, this form provides continued provisional or final approval for coverage under the current General Permit and provides notice that your facility intends to apply for coverage under a new General Permit in the future.
