Certificates and recertifications will be awarded to those who pass the exam, submit this application, and operators also need to submit the certification fee payment. Once the certification program manager receives your application and if applicable, confirmation of payment, your certificate will be mailed to you. Certificates are valid for three years.

Operators: The certification and recertification cost is \$200 and is valid for three years. **This fee must be paid within 30 days of the date of notification** (WAC 173-300-120).
