ITEM	ACCEPTED	NOT ACCEPTED	NOTES
<b>Scrap Metal</b>	Appliances such as stoves, hot water heaters, washers and dryers, barbeques, cast iron sinks and tubs, lawnmowers and other metal items.	No cars, trailers, microwaves, dishwashers or any greasy metal.	Please drain all liquids and remove any plastic or rubber from metal.
<b>Scrap Wood</b>	Clean, unpainted and untreated wood, plywood, pallets, dimensional lumber and crates.	No dirty, painted, treated or laminated wood or particle board.	Nails do not need to be removed.
<b>Bulky Yard Debris</b>	Stumps, logs and tree branches that are at least 3 inches in diameter.	No yard debris such as grass clippings, sod, weeds, small twigs or garden waste.	No assistance is available to unload stumps from vehicles.
<b>Refrigerators, Freezers and Air Conditioners</b>	Household refrigerators, freezers and air conditioners.	No commercial appliances or automobile air conditioning units.	\$10 cash charge for each.
<b>Televisions and Monitors</b>	Televisions and computer monitors.	No commercial equipment.	\$10 cash charge for monitors. \$20 for televisions. \$25 for consoles and oversized televisions.
<b>Electronics</b>	Computer CPUs, keyboards, mice, printers, fax machines, scanners, cell phones and CD/DVD Players.	No commercial equipment.	
<b>Fluorescent Bulbs</b>	Compact fluorescent bulbs, fluorescent tubes and mercury and sodium vapor lamps.	No lighting fixtures or broken tubes.	Double bag and take accidentally broken tubes to Wastemobile.
<b>Petroleum-Based Products</b>	Motor oil, gasoline, diesel fuel, 2-cycle mix, transmission fluid, brake fluid, kerosene, antifreeze and oil filters.	No unmarked or mixed liquids.	Do not mix any of the liquids together.
<b>Tires</b>	Off rim light truck, car and motorcycle tires. Biased, steel-belted and studded tires accepted.	No tires on rim. No tires with an inner circle diameter greater than 18".	Limit of 6 tires per vehicle.
<b>Reusable Household Goods</b>	Small appliances in working condition, reusable clothing, shoes, pots, pans, bedding, books and toys.	No broken, torn, stained or wet items. No furniture, carpet or mattresses.	All items must be clean and in good condition for resale by a charitable organization.
<b>Batteries</b>	Car, truck and marine lead acid batteries. Household alkaline, rechargeable and button batteries.		Please sort large quantities.
 <b>Holiday Lights and Wires</b>	Holiday light strands, cords, cables and wires.		Items will be recycled for scrap metal to raise money for charity ( <a href="http://www.holidaylightsrecycling.com">www.holidaylightsrecycling.com</a> ).

...oil-based paint, pesticides, or household chemicals—take to Household Hazardous Wastemobile at the Commons near Sears 3/14-16 & 3/21-23, 10 am-5 pm. Latex paint no longer accepted—please dry out and place in trash. (206.296.4692, [www.govlink.org/hazwaste/house](http://www.govlink.org/hazwaste/house)).

...garbage—take to the Algona Transfer Station at 35315 W Valley Hwy in Algona. (206.296.6542, [www.metrokc.gov/dnpr/swd/facilities](http://www.metrokc.gov/dnpr/swd/facilities))
