

## Items Must Meet the Following Guidelines.....



You Can Bring...

- **TIRES:** Bias ply, steel belted, and studded tires accepted. **Limit 6 passenger tires per household (18 inches and below) free of charge. \$5 charged for each large truck tire and \$15 charged for each truck tire on rim (cash only). No oversized tires accepted.**
- **LEAD ACID BATTERIES:** Car, truck, marine, and motorcycle batteries accepted.
- **ALKALINE BATTERIES:** AAAA, AAA, AA, A, B, C, and D cell batteries only.
- **MOTOR OIL, FILTERS, & ANTIFREEZE:** Motor oil, oil filters, antifreeze, brake fluid, transmission fluid, 2-cycle oil, steering fluid, crankcase oil, kerosene, and home heating fuel. Do not mix with antifreeze, solvents, gasoline, or other substances.
- **PAINT:** Oil based paint, stains, solvents, and thinners only. **No latex paint or spray paint. Limit of ten containers of paint per participant. Empty used paint containers will be returned to residents.**
- **CARDBOARD:** Please flatten. No wax coated cardboard.
- **PORCELAIN TOILETS AND SINKS:** Toilet seats, hardware, and base wax rings must be removed.
- **PROPANE TANKS:** Residential 5 gallon barbeque tanks only.
- **BULKY WOOD:** Includes tree branches (minimum 6 inches in diameter), logs, clean wood, plywood, pallets, and other untreated and unpainted wood. **No leaves, grass, small branches, sod, brush, painted, or stained wood. Please lay a tarp under material for ease of removal.**
- **APPLIANCES AND SCRAP METAL:** Auto parts, lawn chairs, stoves, appliances, microwaves, barbecues, iron, steel, aluminum, brass, copper and other ferrous and nonferrous metals. **\$5 will be charged for each water heater that still has insulation coating (cash only).** Metals that are insulated, rubber or oil coated, previously or currently contain chemicals, paint, or hazardous materials will not be accepted. Light fixture ballasts and sealed drums will not be accepted.
- **REFRIGERATORS/FREEZERS:** **\$25 will be charged for each refrigerator or freezer.** \$25 will be charged for each household air conditioner (**cash only**).
- **ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT:** DVD players, VCRs, stereo equipment, printers, copiers, fax machines, scanners, and cellular phones. Computers, computer monitors (**no charge**), mouse, and keyboards.
- **TELEVISION SETS:** TV sets encased in plastic, wood console, sets encased in wood, and big screen TVs accepted (**no charge**).
- **FLUORESCENT LIGHTS:** fluorescent tubes and bulbs, incandescent bulbs. Broken lights and light fixture ballasts will not be accepted.



### These household wastes:

- No construction/demolition debris
- No garbage
- No mattresses/furniture
- No plastic toys, hoses, etc.
- No window glass

### These hazardous wastes:

- No pesticides/herbicides
- No household chemicals
- No cleaning products

**Household Hazardous Wastes** (but not latex paint) can be taken to the Household Hazardous Wastemobile or one of three household hazardous waste collection sites. Skykomish residents may use the North Seattle Household Hazardous Waste Facility. It is open 9:30 am – 4:30 pm, Sundays, Mondays and Tuesdays (except holidays). Volume restrictions apply.

You may drop off computers, computer monitors, laptops, and televisions at no charge at the following E-Cycle Washington locations: St. Vincent de Paul (123 North Lewis St, Monroe, WA 98272, 360-794-5723) and Goodwill Monroe Donation Center (18805 State Route 2, Monroe, WA 98272, 206-329-1000). Please note - drop off locations and charges may change and quantities accepted may be limited. Please also note that computer peripherals such as keyboards, mice, and printers are not included in this program but will be accepted for free at the Skykomish Recycling Collection Event.

# Compost Bin Sale

Start backyard composting to save resources and money. Composting is a natural process that turns yard waste into rich soil. Yard waste—grass, leaves, old flowers—contain mostly water. Once the water dries, rich soil is all that's left. Compost bins normally retail for about \$100, but Skykomish residents will pay only \$15. Quantities are very limited. Residents are limited to one compost bin per household.
