## Accepted Materials:

**Cardboard** ~ non-waxed or coated, flattened



**CDs, Floppy Disks, Video Tapes** ~ please remove paper or plastic covers

**Cellular Phones** ~ phones, batteries, chargers, adapters

**Computers & Components** ~ hard drives, monitors (**\$10 charge-cash only**), keyboards, printers, mice

**Fluorescent Lights** ~ fluorescent tubes and bulbs, incandescent bulbs. Broken lights and light fixture ballasts will not be accepted.

**Plastics** ~ grocery bags, stretch wrap, film, bubble wrap, shrink wrap, garment bags

**Scrap Metal** ~ chairs, desks, file cabinets, refrigerators/freezers/cfc units (**\$25 charge-cash only**), telephones, fax machines, type writers, adding machines, copiers, other ferrous and non-ferrous metals. Sealed tanks and drums and metals that are insulated, rubber coated, contain chemicals, paint, or hazardous materials will not be accepted.

**Toner Cartridges**

**TV Sets** - TV sets with 36 inch or smaller screens and encased in plastic (**\$20 charge-cash only**). TV sets with larger than 36 inch screens, wood console, sets encased in wood, and big screen TV sets - (**\$25 charge-cash only**). Projection TV sets (**\$30 charge-cash only**).

**Wood Pallets and Clean, Untreated Scrap Wood**
