ITEM (load order)	ACCEPTED	NOT ACCEPTED	NOTES
<b>Scrap Metal</b>	Appliances such as ovens, stoves, hot water heaters, clothes washers, dryers, barbecues, metal sinks and tubs, lawnmowers and other metal items.	<b>NO</b> car bodies, trailers, microwaves, dishwashers, vacuum cleaners or any greasy metal.	Please drain all liquids and remove any plastic or rubber from metal.
<b>Scrap Wood</b>	Clean, unpainted and untreated wood, plywood, pallets, dimensional lumber and crates.	<b>NO</b> dirty, painted, treated or laminated wood or particle board.	Nails do not need to be removed.
<b>Bulky Brush and Branches</b>	Stumps, logs and tree branches that are at least 3 inches in diameter and less than 4 feet long (those items that don't normally fit in your yard debris cart).	<b>NO</b> yard debris such as grass clippings, sod, weeds, small twigs or garden waste. <b>NO</b> commercial loads.	<b>NO</b> assistance is available to unload stumps from vehicles. <b>Refrigerators, Freezers and Air Conditioners</b>	Household refrigerators, freezers and air conditioners.	<b>NO</b> commercial appliances or automobile air conditioning units.	<b>\$10 cash fee</b> for each.
<b>Televisions and Monitors</b>	Televisions, computer monitors and laptops.	<b>NO</b> commercial equipment.	<b>\$10 cash fee</b> for monitors and laptops. <b>\$20 cash fee</b> for televisions. <b>\$25 cash fee</b> for consoles & oversized televisions.
<b>Electronics</b>	Computer CPUs, keyboards, mice, printers, fax machines, scanners, cell phones, CD/DVD players and stereos.	<b>NO</b> commercial equipment.	Make sure to erase hard drives before recycling.
<b>Fluorescent Bulbs</b>	Compact fluorescent bulbs, fluorescent tubes and mercury and sodium vapor lamps.	<b>NO</b> lighting fixtures or broken tubes.	Double bag and take accidentally broken tubes to Wastemobile (see below for details).
<b>Petroleum-Based Products</b>	Motor oil, gasoline, diesel fuel, 2-cycle mix, transmission fluid, brake fluid, kerosene, antifreeze and oil filters.	<b>NO</b> unmarked or mixed liquids.	Do not mix any liquids together. Please ensure containers are clearly labeled with contents.
<b>Tires</b>	Light truck, car and motorcycle tires. Steel-belted and studded tires accepted.	<b>NO</b> tires with an inner circle diameter greater than 18 inches.	Limit of 6 tires per vehicle.
<b>Reusable Household Goods</b>	Small appliances in working condition, reusable clothing, shoes, pots, pans, bedding, books and toys.	<b>NO</b> broken, torn, stained, damaged or wet items. <b>NO</b> furniture, carpet, mattresses or large appliances.	All items must be clean and in good enough condition for resale by a charitable organization.
<b>Batteries</b>	Car, truck and marine lead acid batteries. Household alkaline, rechargeable and button batteries.		Please sort large quantities by type.
<b>NEW Rigid Plastic</b>	Nursery pots, flowerpots, flats, greenhouse sheeting and other rigid plastic.	<b>NO</b> Styrofoam. <b>NO</b> hazardous chemical containers or food residues.	
<b>Wires and Holiday Light Strands</b>	Holiday light strands (bulbs ok), cords and wires.		Items will be recycled for scrap metal to raise money for charities. For more information, visit <a href="http://www.holidaylightsrecycling.com">www.holidaylightsrecycling.com</a> .
<b>NEW Packing Peanuts</b>	Clean packing peanuts.	<b>NO</b> styrofoam blocks.	Please contain packing peanuts in a box or bag.

## How should I load my car?

To ease offloading, follow the arrow above—put scrap metal in first (last item to offload), and packing peanuts in last (first item to offload).

## What can't I bring?

Do **NOT** bring garbage—put in curbside garbage can or take to Algona Transfer Station • 35315 W Valley Hwy • Algona • 206.296.6542 • [www.metrokc.gov/dnrp/swd/facilities](http://www.metrokc.gov/dnrp/swd/facilities)

## Free Electronics Recycling Next Year

Yes, you read that correctly. Hold on to your TVs and computers for a few more months, then you can recycle them for free. A new Washington State law provides free and convenient electronics recycling to residents starting in 2009. For more details, visit [ecyclewashington.org](http://ecyclewashington.org).

- WHO?** Households, small businesses, charities and school districts can participate.
- WHAT?** Only televisions, desktop computers, laptop computers and monitors are included in this program.
- WHEN?** Starting January 2, 2009.
- WHY?** Electronic products contain hazardous chemicals that require special handling for recycling and, as a result, are banned from disposal in King County.
- WHERE?** Collection sites are still being determined. Call 1-800-RECYCLE or visit [1800recycle.wa.gov](http://1800recycle.wa.gov).
- HOW?** Computer and television manufacturers are providing recycling of their electronic products.
- WHAT ELSE?** These items will not be collected at Federal Way recycling events starting in 2009. However, other electronics (printers, CD/DVD players, cell phones) will still be accepted at the recycling events free of charge.
