

Garbage Service Providers in Snohomish County


If recycling, construction and demolition job sites in Snohomish County must have a separate, properly-identified container for non-recyclable CDL waste and garbage, and those materials must be disposed at a Snohomish County solid waste facility.

Contractors can “self-haul” waste for disposal to these facilities or hire a local garbage hauling company. Companies that can legally haul garbage for hire are limited to those listed below.

Use this map and guide to determine who your garbage hauler is. If unsure, provide the garbage company with the address/location of the job site and they will tell you if they are your garbage service provider.
