

Garbage Service Providers in Snohomish County


If recycling, construction and demolition job sites in Snohomish County must have a separate, properly-identified container for non-recyclable CDL waste and garbage, and those materials must be disposed at a Snohomish County solid waste facility.

Contractors can “self-haul” waste for disposal to these facilities (see back) or hire a local garbage hauling company. Companies that can legally haul garbage for hire are limited to those listed below.

Use this map and guide to determine who your garbage hauler is. If unsure, provide the garbage company with the address/location of the job site and they will tell you if they are your garbage service provider.

Prohibited:

- Top loaded/open top containers on rolling chassis
- Vehicles with containers that do not have a hydraulic dump system longer than 25'
- Vehicles with containers requiring to be top picked off the chassis

Transfer Station Rates

- Garbage \$105/ton (\$20 min. fee up to 360 lbs.)
- Recycling yard/wood debris (Transfer Stations only) \$45/ton (\$11 min. fee up to 500 lbs.)



NRDC Rates

- Garbage \$20 min. fee (up to 1 cu. yd.); \$20 each additional cu. yd. (totals rounded up/down to the nearest dollar); maximum 5 cu. yd.

How to Calculate NRDC Disposal Fees

- Measure the load's length, width and height (in feet).
- Multiply them together.
- Divide by 27 (equals the cubic yards).
- Multiply the answer by \$20 and round to the nearest dollar (\$20 minimum fee).



Recycling Options

Yard and wood debris can be recycled for a reduced rate of \$45/ton at Snohomish County Transfer Stations.
