Prescribed medications:

Accepted **ONLY** at law enforcement sites:

- Narcotics (Vicodin, oxycodone, etc.)

Accepted at all sites:

- Medication samples
- Medications for pets
- Medicated ointments/lotions (prescription & over-the-counter)



Over-the-counter medications



Vitamins



Inhalers



EpiPens (unopened)

Items NOT Accepted:

- Needles/syringes
- Thermometers
- IV bags or bloody/infectious waste
- Personal care products
- Hydrogen peroxide/other chemicals
- Aerosol cans
- EpiPens (used)
- Mercury products (Mercurochrome, thimerosal, etc.)
- Iodine solutions (Betadine, tincture of iodine, etc.)
- Radioactives
- Business waste
- Empty containers
