ITEM	ACCEPTED	NOTES
<b>Appliances and Scrap Metal</b>	Auto parts, engines and gas lawnmowers ( <u>drained of oil and gasoline</u> ), metal lawn chairs, stoves, microwaves, barbecues, steel, aluminum, brass, copper and other ferrous and non-ferrous metals. <b>\$5 will be charged for each water heater that still has insulation coating. CASH ONLY</b>	Drain all liquids. Metals that are insulated, rubber or oil coated, previously or currently contain chemicals, gas, oil, paint or hazardous materials will not be accepted. Light fixture ballasts and sealed drums will not be accepted.
<b>Propane Tanks</b>	Residential tanks only. \$5 each. Small canisters up to 16.5 oz, \$1 each. <b>CASH ONLY</b>	
<b>Porcelain Toilets &amp; Sinks</b>	\$5 each item. <b>CASH ONLY</b>	Toilet seat, base & wax rings must be removed.
<b>Refrigerators, Freezers and Air Conditioners</b>	\$25 charge for each unit. <b>CASH ONLY</b>	No commercial units or automobile air conditioners.
<b>Televisions, Computers, Monitors &amp; Laptops</b>	<b>Not accepted at event</b>	Take to the Kent Goodwill Store, 25814 102nd Pl. SE any day at no charge. More info at 253.573.1333
<b>Electronics</b>	Keyboards, printers, fax machines, scanners, cell phones, CD/DVD players and stereos.	<b>No computers, monitors, laptops or TVs</b>
<b>Petroleum-Based Products</b>	Motor oil, oil filters, gasoline, diesel fuel, 2-cycle mix, transmission fluid, brake fluid, antifreeze, kerosene, and home heating fuel.	<b>No unmarked or mixed liquids. Do not mix any of the liquids together.</b>
<b>Tires: Car, Light Truck &amp; Motorcycle</b>	Biased, steel-belted & studded tires accepted. Limit of 8 passenger tires (18" and below)—Free. Passenger tires on rims—\$1.50 each. \$5 for each large truck tire, \$15 if on rims. <b>CASH ONLY</b>	
<b>Reusable Household Goods</b>	Small appliances in working condition, reusable clothing, shoes, pots, pans, bedding, books and toys. All items must be clean and in good condition for resale by a charity.	<b>No broken, torn, stained or wet items. No furniture, carpet or mattresses.</b>
<b>Shredding</b>	Limit of 3 file-size boxes per vehicle—no exceptions.	Service donated by Shred-It, located in Kent.
<b>Concrete, Asphalt, Rock &amp; Brick</b>	Place on tarp for easy removal. Rocks and smaller materials must be in boxes or buckets.	Remove plastic, metal and wood. Residential material only.
<b>Cardboard</b>	Please flatten boxes.	No wax-coated cardboard.
<b>Batteries</b>	Car, truck, marine and motorcycle batteries. Alkaline Batteries AAAA, AAA, AA, A, B, C, & D cell batteries only.	
 <b>Mattresses</b>	This is a pilot project. Mattresses, box springs and futons, any size. \$10 per mattress, box spring, or futon. Vendor reserves the right to refuse any item it cannot recycle. No furniture or frames. No wet or soiled items.	

**PLEASE NOTE: No vehicles may enter after 3 p.m. No flatbeds or dump trucks allowed. We reserve the right to refuse oversized, commercial, contaminated, excessive or unacceptable loads.**

*This program is only for household materials from King County residents. Funding provided by City of Kent Public Works Department, King County Solid Waste Division, Washington State Department of Ecology and the Local Hazardous Waste Management Program in King County.*

## **DON'T BRING THESE HOUSEHOLD WASTES:**

- **NO** construction/demolition debris
- **NO** bulky wood
- **NO** grass, leaves, or small yard debris
- **NO** garbage
- **NO** window glass/mirrors
- **NO** latex paint (see note below)
- **NO** plastic or plastic pools, toys, hoses, etc.
- **NO** painted/treated wood
- **NO** Styrofoam
- **NO** carpeting

Latex paint, if less than a quarter can-full, may be dried out by leaving the lid off, and placed in the garbage once dry. Share larger amounts with friends, donate to a local theater group, or dry by adding equal amounts of cat litter or paint hardener. Donate full cans to Habitat for Humanity: 206.292.5240

## **DON'T BRING THESE HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTES:**

- **NO** oil based paint
- **NO** solvents and thinners
- **NO** cleaning products
- **NO** pesticides/herbicides
- **NO** household chemicals
- **NO** fluorescent lights

Household hazardous waste can be disposed of at Wastemobile sites.

Regular **Wastemobile** service is now available at the Auburn SuperMall (near the loading docks and Sports Authority) every 1st and 3rd full weekend of the month, 10 am - 5 pm. If the first day of the month is a Saturday, the Wastemobile will not be open until the following weekend.

**Please Note:** If bringing motor (crankcase) oil to the Wastemobile, be sure to keep it separate from all other fluids.
