

What to Bring

Load heaviest items first, lightest last

Concrete, Asphalt & Rock

Please assist in the unloading of your vehicle.

Roofing Shingles

Asphalt and wood shingles.

Carpet, Sheetrock & Porcelain

Only dry carpet and sheetrock, porcelain, toilets and sinks. **Remove all non-porcelain hardware.**

NEW Reusable Building Materials

The RE Store will collect clean lumber, shelving, light fixtures, sinks, tubs, etc. for reuse. **Reusability is dependent upon condition and marketability.**

Scrap Metal

Lawn mowers, ovens, stoves, hot water heaters, washers, dryers, barbeques, etc. **Remove all non-metal parts and drain all liquids.**

Small Electronics

Note: NO computers, monitors, televisions or laptops. Phones, mice, keyboards, printers, etc.

Plate Glass

Window glass with or without frames. **No mirrors.**

Bicycles

All types, conditions and parts.

Motor Oil, Antifreeze & Filters

DO NOT mix fluids. No gasoline.

Cardboard

Clean and dry.

Styrofoam Blocks & Packing Peanuts

Blocks should be clean, white and break into loose beads.

No Garbage

No Yard Waste

Visit the Shoreline Recycling & Transfer Station for disposal

Do Not Bring

- Mirrors
- Doors, cabinets & wall paneling
- Tiling & linoleum
- Hazardous materials—paint, fluorescent bulbs & tubes, propane tanks.
- TVs, computers, monitors & laptops
- Refrigerators, freezers & air conditioners
- Mattresses
- Hot Tubs
