Here's How it Works:

- Request a voucher by May 18, 2012. Here's how:
 - Online – at www.ci.bothell.wa.us.
 - By mail – complete, detach, add postage, and mail the request form.
 - In person – drop off completed request form at the City of Bothell Public Works Department (Dawson Building), 9654 NE 182nd St., Bothell (Mon-Fri: 8 am - 5 pm). **Limit one voucher per household. City of Bothell residents only.**
- Vouchers will be mailed out as they are requested continuously until May 18, 2012 and issued in the name of the person who requested it.
- The voucher is valued at \$20.00 to apply toward fees for the recyclable items accepted at the Shoreline Recycling & Transfer Station. See "Materials Covered by Voucher" for details. **The voucher does not cover garbage fees, and is good only until May 31, 2012.**
- Bring your recyclable items and your voucher to the Shoreline Recycling & Transfer Station on or before May 31, 2012. **Please note:** if the cost of a visit to the transfer station is more than the voucher's value of \$20.00, the person whose name appears on the voucher is the responsible party for the additional costs in all instances, including transfer to another party. **The City of Bothell will bill the responsible party for any costs over \$20.00.**
