



Spring Recycling Collection Event

Your voucher is enclosed. A complete list of the accepted materials below. Green boxes have FREE items. Directions and hours of operation is listed on the back.

Materials Covered by Voucher

Large appliances \$24 refrigerant type, \$10 other large

Includes appliances that contain or contained refrigerants (refrigerators, freezers, etc.) and other large appliances (hot water heaters, stoves, dishwashers, dehumidifiers, etc.). Limit 3 per load. Appliances must be empty. No commercial appliances.

Scrap metal (including tin and aluminum)

Clean wood

\$82.50 per ton, \$13.25 minimum fee (up to 340 lbs.)

Includes plywood, construction lumber (nails are OK), oriented strand board (OSB), pallets, lath (no plaster), shingles, stumps, and branches. No items longer than 8 ft. **No painted, stained or treated wood.** Clean wood must be separated from garbage.

Yard waste \$82.50 per ton, \$13.25 minimum fee

Includes compostable items - grass, leaves, brush, weeds, Christmas trees, branches. (OK to put food scraps & food-soiled paper, such as pizza boxes, in with yard waste). No dirt or sod. **No items longer than 8 ft.** Yard waste must be separated from garbage. No meat or dairy food scraps.

Fluorescent light bulbs and tubes \$0.80 per item

Limit 12 per load. See back panel for more tools/resources.

Medical sharps

Includes hypodermic needles, syringes with needles attached, intravenous (IV) tubing with needles attached, scalpel blades and lancets that have been removed from the original sterile packaging. Sharps must be in puncture-proof and leak-resistant plastic container. **Home generated sharps only. No loose sharps.**

Bicycles (Bikes) and Bike Parts

Bikes and bike parts for reuse and recycling. Bikes that can be refurbished are delivered to Bike Works, a non profit organization that builds sustainable communities by educating youth and promoting bicycling.

Textiles (before the station entrance)

Includes reusable clothing, boots, shoes, curtains, fabric, linens, blankets, stuffed animals, and area rugs for reuse and recycling. **No mattresses, box springs, carpet, or carpet padding.**

Instructions

Bring your recyclable items and your voucher to the Shoreline Recycling & Transfer Station on or before May 31, 2012. The cashier will assist you in processing your items and submitting your voucher.

Please note: if the cost of a visit to the transfer station is more than the voucher's value of \$20.00, the person whose name appears on the voucher is the responsible party for the additional costs in all instances, including transfer to another party.

The City of Bothell will bill the responsible party for any costs over \$20.00.

Shoreline, WA 98133

From I-5 Northbound:

- Take Exit #175 (N 145th St.);
- Turn Left on N 145th St.;
- Turn Right on N Meridian Ave.;
- Turn Right on N 165th St.;
- Follow road into Transfer Station.

From I-5 Southbound:

- Take Exit #176 (N 175th St., Shoreline);
- Turn Right on N 175th St.;
- Turn Left on N Meridian Ave.;
- Turn Left on N 165th St.;
- Follow road into Transfer Station.

From the West:

- Head East on N 175th St. or N 145th St.;
- Turn on N Meridian Ave. to N 165th St.;
- Turn East on N 165th St. into Transfer Station.
