Concrete, Asphalt & Rock	Assist in unloading your vehicle. <u>No gravel. No painted bricks.</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Garbage • Yard Debris • Tile & linoleum • Mattresses • Mirrors • Hot tubs • Tires • Doors, cabinets and wall paneling • Items with bees, hornets or wasps • Hazardous materials - paint, fluorescent bulbs & tubes, propane tanks. Call (206) 296-4692 or visit lhwmp.org
Roofing Shingles	Asphalt and wood shingles in old and new condition.	
Carpet, Sheetrock & Porcelain	Only dry carpet and sheetrock, porcelain, toilets and sinks. <u>Remove all non-porcelain hardware.</u>	
Scrap Metal	Refrigerators, freezers, AC units, ovens, stoves, hot water heaters, washers, dryers. Lawn mowers, barbeques, etc. <u>Remove all non-metal parts and drain all liquids.</u>	
Electronics	Televisions, computers, monitors, laptops, phones, cables, keyboards, printers, microwaves, etc.	
Plate Glass	Window glass with or without frames.	
Styrofoam Blocks & Packing Peanuts	Blocks should be clean, white and break into loose beads.
