3-BIN COMPOSTING DEMONSTRATED AT 2012 COUNTY FAIR



A public workshop on how to construct a 3-bin composting system for larger volumes of materials was held in early August. The finished bins were used as a demonstration display at the County Fair.

The whole system was then re-located to the community garden across from the Friday Harbor Middle/High Schools where it will serve as an ongoing educational tool.
