RE: Samra Farms LLC Request for Extension of Trust Water Donations CG4-23992(B)C and CG4-23992(C)C.

Dear Sir or Madam:

The purpose of this letter is to acknowledge your request to extend the above referenced temporary Trust Water Donations for an additional year.

The Department of Ecology (Ecology) pursuant to Chapter 90.42.080(1)(b) accepts your request to lengthen the term of Trust Water Donations CG4-23992(B)C and CG4-23992(C)C through the 2018 irrigation season. The quantities of the donations shall remain the same; 503.6 acre-feet donated under Water Right Certificate No. G4-23992(B)C, and 349 acre-feet donated under Water Right Certificate No. G4-23992(C)C. Ecology acknowledges that the portion of each water right not donated to the Trust Water Rights Program (TWRP) shall be used for irrigation throughout the April 1 to October 1, irrigation season but the water use may be relocated within the legal Place of Use for the corresponding water right.

The new expiration date for Trust Water Donations CG4-23992(B)C and CG4-23992(C)C is March 31, 2019.

Please keep in mind that under RCW 90.42.080(4) the total of any portion of the water right remaining with the donor plus the donated portion of the water right may not exceed the extent to which the water right was exercised during the five years before the donation period started.

If, prior to expiration of the temporary donations, you would like to extend the donations once again, please send us a written request. Also, if you wish to modify any terms of the donation(s), your letter must include the new terms. Ecology will review your request and any new or modified terms and conditions and will notify you whether the donation(s) can be extended or terminated.
