ORDER FOR RELIEF FROM CONDITIONAL FINAL ORDER DUE TO CLERICAL ERROR

CLAIM NOS. 02222 AND 01676

SUBBASIN NO. 5 (ELK HEIGHTS)

This matter came before the Court on Plaintiff State of Washington, Department of Ecology's Motion for Relief From Conditional Final Order Due To Clerical Error, Court Claim Nos. 02222 and 01676, Subbasin No. 5 (Elk Heights). The current claimants for Court Claim No. 02222 are, Brian and Elizabeth Frederick and J. Clyde Curfew and Leslie A. Curfew: and for Court Claim No. 01676, Hein & Hein Enterprise LLC; Real Estate Investment Group; Jon L. Newton, Trustee of the Sara Michelle Newton Trust Brain; and Brian and Elizabeth Frederick. The Court having heard from all interested parties and being fully advised:

NOW, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED ADJUDGED AND DECREED:

- 1. The Court directs that the Conditional Final Order for Subbasin No. 5 (Elk Heights) be corrected to place a "Limitation of Use" on the water rights confirmed under Court Claim Nos. 02222 and 01676 as follows: This water right authorizes diversion of Yakima River water for periods only during irrigation season when water is available in the Teanaway River to fulfill the Class 16 right (June 30, 1900).
- 2. The Court authorizes the Department of Ecology to include this "Limitation of Use" in the Certificates of Water Right to be issued upon entry of the final Decree.
- 3. The "Limitation of Use" provision takes effect immediately.
