

7. Remarks and Other Relevant Information:

This is the Patricia Darling Strong portion of 6 change applications submitted by Washington Water Trust on behalf of David Joseph and Lona Jeannine Darling, The Estate of David C. Darling, Patricia Darling Strong, Davida Lynn Burns, and Gayle Darling Longley.

The water right is a portion of Court Claim No. 00176 in Subbasin 2 of the Yakima General Adjudication with priority dates of June 30, 1887 and June 30, 1889 confirmed to C Frederick Darling by way of a February 13, 1997 Conditional Final Order (CFO) for Sub-basin 2 (Easton). Mr. Darling passed away in 2011, and on January 27, 2012, Yakima Superior Court issued an Amended Order Dividing Water Right and Substituting Parties Defendant. Attached as **Exhibit A is a copy of the confirmed water right for Court Claim No. 00176 as it appears in the CFO, and the 1/27/2012 Division and Substitution of Parties.**

On December 12, 2013 Washington Water Trust obtained an *Order Pedente Lite* (OPL) changing the purpose of use of water rights associated with the above heirs to the Fred Darling Estate to instream flow until April 30, 2016. **The final OPL is attached as Exhibit B. The Parcel records showing ownership of the property are attached as Exhibit C.** the underlying water right to which the water right will revert at the end of the lease term is appurtenant to 7.2 Acres located within Lot 8 of Surveys, recorded under Kittitas County Auditor's Recording No. 201004130016, being a portion of the SE ¼ of Section 20, T. 20 N., R. 14 E.W.M. As a result of this transaction, it is intended that 50 percent of the water right, not including any consumptive quantities of water, will be deeded to the TWRP in perpetuity, and that 50 percent of the water right, included all consumptive quantities of water, will be retained by the water rights owner.

Use of water rights on the property for all companion change applications is included in **Exhibit D, entitled "Beneficial Use Report"** and incorporated by this reference. This will be provided to Ecology as a single document referencing all of the water rights. **Landowner agreements are included as Exhibit E, and a Project Map as Exhibit F.**

Big Creek is an important system for ESA listed mid-Columbia steelhead and spring Chinook, as well as bull trout and resident trout. In Big Creek low flow, water temperature, and passage barriers have been identified as limiting factors for these species. We anticipate this project to address these limiting factors, and, as such, request that this application receive expedited processing in accordance with WAC 173-152-050(2)(b) and (3)(a) under RCW 90.03.655. We also hereby request that the project be processed using the cost reimbursement program under RCW 90.03.265.

Certain applications may incur a Real Estate Excise Tax liability for the seller of the water rights. The Department of Revenue has requested notification of potential taxable water right related actions and therefore may be provided with a copy of this request.


