7. Remarks and Other Relevant Information:

The purpose of this application is to permanently donate the conserved water from a piping project into the Trust Water Rights Program to benefit Peshastin Creek. Peshastin Irrigation District (PID) seeks to change the purpose of use of 90 acre-feet/year and .3 cfs to instream flow, calculated from the water conserved as a result of the piping project shown in the appended documents. This application is being accompanied by a letter amending the 2012 application to reduce the instream flow quantities of that 25 year agreement to .9 cfs and 270 acre-feet/year, such that the total of the two application is 1.2 cfs and 360 acre-feet/year. The trust water reach will extend from the point of diversion, as listed in Section 4, to the historic point of return flows. This will benefit salmon and bull trout, and rearing for spring Chinook, steelhead and bull trout, particularly by addressing flow and temperature concerns in the lower 2.4 miles of Peshastin Creek. This water will provide significant public benefit for fish restoration in the system, and as such would qualify for priority processing under Chapter 173-152 WAC. The trust water right will be met via delivery and measurement terms of the attached grant agreement between PID, Chelan County, and the Office of the Columbia River. Supplemental information regarding the project and historic beneficial use are included in the application packet accompanying the 2012 application.

Certain applications may incur a Real Estate Excise Tax liability for the seller of the water rights. The Department of Revenue has requested notification of potential taxable water right related actions and therefore may be provided with a copy of this request.


