Project Summary (Please be specific about every detail):

The project area is located in the NW1/4 of Section 14, except for that area in the NW1/4 NW1/4 of Section 14 lying north of the Town Ditch, being within the NW1/4 of Section 14, T. 17 N., R. 19 E.W.M.

The project area is approximately 126 acres and has traditionally been rill irrigated with water from Caribou Creek, Cascade Irrigation District (CID), and Ellensburg Water Company (EWC, aka Town Ditch). There are two different Caribou Ck water rights for this project.

The Caribou Ck (S4-84426-J) gravity diversion (#3) for the property north of the EWC canal is located 825 feet north and 1815 feet west of the southeast corner of Section 11, being within the SW1/4 SE1/4 of Section 11, T. 17 N., R. 19 E.W.M. When needed, the CID water is delivered in Caribou Ck and is also diverted out of this diversion. This diversion does not have a NOAA compliant screen and is a passage barrier during the irrigation season but there is a plan in place to move the diversion upstream to an existing compliant gravity diversion (#1) as soon as funds become available to install a necessary pipeline. This water right is for 100 acres of which 34 acres are in the project area.

The Caribou Ck (S4-84501-J) gravity diversion for the property south of the EWC canal is located 850 feet north and 1225 feet east from the west quarter corner of Section 14, being within the SW1/4 NE1/4 of Section 14, T. 17 N., R. 19 E.W.M. This diversion serves a total of 30 acres of land located on either side of Caribou Ck. The gravity diversion consist of check boards and is not properly screened and doesn't provide fish passage. This point of diversion will be moved upstream to an existing compliant gravity diversion and the check structure will be removed in the near future. The property below the EWC canal is also served by EWC water.

The saved water from both Caribou Creek water rights is estimated at 0.411 cfs and 91.99 acre feet. Therefore 0.08 cfs and 31.34 acre feet will be trusted for instream flows for the June 30, 1870 (S4-84426-J) water right and 0.331 cfs and 60.65 acre feet will be trusted for the February 10, 1875 (S4-84501-J) water right.

Caribou Creek is part of the Upper Yakima Suspended Sediment TMDL. The pivot sprinkler is estimated to reduce soil erosion by 1.6 tons per acre per year in this project area. The estimated soil savings is 201.6 tons per year.
