

6. Remarks and Other Relevant Information:

This certificate was changed by prior owners (Sunshine Agriculture Incorporated) under No. CS4-28101C. Later, errors in some of the source locations were found. Also the prior owners were concerned about the lower water duties in the change authorization. The current owner / applicant would like to follow up and resolve these concerns brought up by the prior owner. This change application seeks to correct the source locations. At the same time, the change process can be used to make a showing of actual use and establish an accurate water duty. A final consideration is, the certificate place of use includes lands not owned by the applicant. The applicant only intends to make changes relevant to its land ownership and irrigated acres. The applicant will follow a process acceptable to the water board to segregate its water right from that of other owners if any.

This authorization to use public waters of the state is classified as a FAMILY FARM PERMIT in accordance with Chapter 90.66 RCW (Initiative Measure No. 59). This means the land being irrigated under this authorization shall comply with the following definition: Family Farm - a geographic area including not more than 2,000 acres of irrigated agricultural lands, whether contiguous or noncontiguous, the controlling interest in which is held by a person having a controlling interest in no more than 2,000 acres of irrigated agricultural lands in the State of Washington which are irrigated under water rights acquired after December 8, 1977. Furthermore, the land being irrigated under this authorization must continue to conform to the definition of a family farm.

This authorization is subject to the following minimum flow provisions as specified in WAC 173-563-040 and WAC 173-563-050 and the following table. It is subject to regulation by the Department of Ecology for protection of instream resources whenever the March 1 forecast of April-September runoff at The Dalles is 60 MAF or less, and when gaged flows are predicted by the BPA 30-Day Power Operation Plan to violate the following minimum flow provisions at:

* For the reach from Grand Coulee through Wanapum, minimum average weekly flows shall be as shown above, or as necessary to maintain minimum flows (subject to low runoff adjustment) at Priest Rapids, whichever is higher. As provided in WAC 173-563-050(1), the minimum average weekly flows set forth in this subsection are subject to a reduction of up to 25 percent during low flow years, except that in no case shall the outflow from Priest Rapids Dam be less than 36,000 cfs.

Use of water under this authorization shall be contingent upon the water right holders' utilization of up-to-date water conservation practices and maintenance of efficient water delivery systems consistent with established regulation requirements and facility capabilities.

Use of water under this authorization can be expected to be curtailed at least once in every 20 years.
