Dear Debra:

This letter accompanies a Change in Point of Diversion application for Frank Gollaher representing Gollaher Family LLC. Gollaher currently diverts from the Gaines Ditch (GD) ditch just upstream of the Roaring Creek Bridge in the Entiat basin, although he is permitted to divert at the same location as Randy Whitehall (CCVOL1P301). Gollaher is requesting to add a point of diversion (POD) to one well. This application for CCVOL1P301 is part of an overall Cascadia Conservation District (CCD) surface to wells strategy to decrease direct withdrawal from the Entiat River. An application for an additional well related to water right WRC 136626 was submitted on April 18, 2011. These proposed wells, coupled with cooperation from other users who are switching to wells, may lead to decommissioning the Entiat River point of diversion for the GD upon the wells proven capacity.

Under CCVOL1P301, Gollaher Family LLC irrigates 16.5 acres of a combination of fruit orchard and pasture on parcels #252003430250, 252003430300 and 252010110100. All potential irrigable lots are owned and managed by Gollaher. In addition, CCVOL1P301 is appurtenant to the following parcels: 252003410050, 252003430050 and 252003420350.

Historical Use

Historical water use under CCVOL1P301 has not been measured, as there is no meter on this ditch. Water use was estimated by using the water duties as provided in the Entiat Watershed Plan, approved in 2004. Since 1917, water has been diverted and used from April through November annually.

Project Description

CCD and the Washington Water Project-TU (WWP-TU) are working with all the landowners that use the Gaines Ditch. Moving these landowners to wells will reduce surface withdrawal from the Entiat River as well as the annual maintenance which occurs at the current POD. The Gaines Ditch point of diversion is located at approximately river mile 6.5.
