**7. Remarks and Other Relevant Information:**

**7.1**

This sprinkler conversion project and associated trust application is part of the Manastash Creek Restoration Project, which is working to improve fish habitat for listed Mid-Columbia summer steelhead, as well as other salmonids and resident fish species, by providing fish passage and fish screening and enhancing instream flow in Manastash Creek. The project is working to open 25 miles of fish habitat in the Creek by providing fish passage and screening for seven irrigation diversions and by improving instream flow in a 3-mile stretch of Creek that is seasonally dry. The Manastash Creek Restoration Project "Implementation Plan" details improvements to instream flow conditions in Manastash Creek through voluntary water conservation and acquisition projects.

The Applicant, through a cost share agreement with KCCD, will upgrade from rill irrigation to a more efficient corner pivot sprinkler system. The saved water from the conversion will be trusted in perpetuity to the Washington Trust Water Right Program for instream flow enhancement in Manastash Creek. Currently, the Applicant utilizes rill irrigation to irrigate a 100-acre section of Timothy hay on their property. Approximately 97.8 acres will be converted to a pivot sprinkler; approximately 2.2 acres will remain in rill irrigation. The 100-acre section of land **does not** have supplemental water rights from the Kittitas Reclamation District (KRD) or West Side Irrigating Company.

For this project, the Applicant proposes to trust the following amounts listed below when the full instantaneous rates are available. Additional pro-rationing of trust water can occur as Creek flows recede. There are two separate water rights and trust applications associated with this sprinkler conversion project.
