Application Item No. 3. Distances to wells.

Existing Two Wells in close proximity located, from permit:

880 feet south and 200 feet east from the north quarter corner of Section 12, T. 20 N., R. 22 E.W.M., within NW1/4NE1/4.

Proposed Well:

1290 feet north and 150 feet west from the SE corner of Section 12, T. 20 N., R. 22 E.W.M., within SE1/4SE1/4.

Application Item No. 5. Remarks.

Request is to formalize a compensating non-use by Painted Summer Hills under G4-29196P for the Jeff Jones property which has had a prior and continuing use for irrigation of approx. 6 acres of vineyard from a well on that same property. G4-29196P is a developing permit which had initial orchard development pushed out (see aerial photo believed to be from 2004 showing orchard). The Painted Summer Hills owners have agreed to reserve 9 ac-ft and 35 gpm unused for 2012. More than six acres is unused for 2012 and prior use for orchard on six acres would have typically been closer to 24 ac-ft and 60 gpm actual historic use (greater than transfer request). The G4-29196P place of use location of the six acres, or equivalent acres to the 9 ac-ft quantity, is somewhat arbitrary but can be identified upon request.

No well report was found for the subject well, drilled by prior owners, but information given to Jeff Jones was as follows:

- 390 feet deep well penetrating 50 feet of sand and then basalt to depth.
- 8 inch casing installed to a 60 feet depth
- no water level information provided.

Expected use is 1.5 feet water duty on 6 acres or 9 ac-ft, and 35 gpm; drip irrigation of vineyard.
